8/ 2017 Queensland Dilute Championships and Colourama

The Colourama and the Championships have been run & won. Despite some major setbacks, the shows went on, but numbers at both shows were down 50%. The organisers were grateful for the competitors that did come along and were tolerant of the emergency arrangements that had to be made.

Dave Maclean our Chairman of the Board and SA Director, and Jan Sheehan, SA Director & SA Branch Secretary travelled up to Queensland to help us out with the show. We could not have done it without them. Dave even took up Leanne Owen's camera and became the photographer while Leanne was in the ring competing.

Special mention must be made of Toneal Hoffman and her palomino ASH mare LOVE ME DO who had one of those weekends that showies dream of. This lovely homebred mare came away from the two shows winning both Colourama Supreme of Supremes Led Exhibit and the Championships Supreme Led Dilute Exhibit. The icing on the cake was Love Me do also being awarded Supreme Under Saddle at both shows. Toneal had offered a service to her palomino ASH stallion WALLARAE DEE BAR ROMEO as a prize on the weekend and Romeo is the sire of Love Me Do, so that alone should interest mare owners. The winner of the service has not been announced to date.

The quality of dilutes on both days was exceptional and mentioned by the judges from both shows.

2018 Shows - The Branch will be looking for at a new venue/s for next year's shows, so if you have any suggestions for a suitable venue, contact Tania. Requirements - outdoor arena / good quality safe stables / clean showers & toilets / camping /reasonable hire out rates.

9/ 2017/18 Dilutes Australia National Supreme Champion Led & Under Saddle

This year the Qld Branch has a single horse winning both Led & Under Saddle Supremes and therefore has qualified for both National Supreme Champions. The palomino mare LOVE ME DO and breeder/owner/exhibitor Toneal Hoffman has made Toneal's 40th Birthday a very special one. Let's hope that Queensland can bring home BOTH National Supremes this year. If you are on facebook keep your eye out for news. The Victorian Championships are in October, followed by the ACT/NSW Branch in November and then Tasmania, South Australia and Western Australia starting first weekend in December and following each weekend afterwards. Then off to the judges for voting, and then back to Dave to calculate the winners and finally the announcement.

10/ News from the Board Meeting in May

- 1. Members now have the option of supplying their banking details to the National Treasurer for EFT transactions for reimbursement for overpay refunds etc.
- 2. Public Liability Insurance changes: Affinity has removed the requirement for us to charge a Non Member Event Insurance fee. The Board has decided that to help pay our Premium a Non Member Showing Levy will now be in effect.
 - a) EVERYONE attending a Branch-run show MUST sign a Waiver. There are 2 Waivers to choose from An adult and a Child.
 - b) EVERYONE listed on a membership is covered by the PL Insurance and don't pay the Non Member Showing Levy fee of \$15. The new membership cards will not have all members' names listed on them, but the accompanying letter will. So the card and the letter will be required to be shown. If no proof shown then the person will have to pay the \$15 Levy. Still have to sign a Waiver.
 - c) For people who are non-members who help out members at shows and were previously listed on memberships and paid a \$45 fee there is now offered a \$20 Annual Non-member Showing Levy. This MUST be submitted with a membership name & ID number to attach it to. There is a separate form for lodging and a card will be issued.
 - d) For anyone who does not have a current membership card & letter or current Annual Non Member Showing Levy card, the \$15 Levy fee must be paid to receive an armband.
- 3. EXPRESS registration processing: You now have the option of Express Processing for when you are in a hurry. The fee is \$20 and the time frame is 3 days. The 3 days starts from when all documents and photos are correctly lodged and proof of payment of correct fees accompanies it. If anything is not correct then the 3 days starts from the time everything is lodged correctly. This is, of course, an online option only.

 The Registrar now offers ONLINE forms that can be completed online.
- 4. Broken Coloured Dilute (BCD) Showing Register: The owners of all horses registered as a BCD and who have not had their BCDs transferred to the DA Non Solid Dilute Registry have been notified that their registration as a BCD needs to be transferred as the BCD Showing Registry has been discontinued. Any horse that has not been upgraded to the DA NSD register will no longer be able to be shown in the dilute ring. As the DA NSD is a full status register compared to the old BCD register which was a showing only registry, the change is a big plus.
- 5. Dilutes Australia has changed the name <u>Black Buckskin</u> to <u>Smoky Black</u> & added <u>Smoky Cream</u> to the Cremello & Perlino Register to denote double cream on a black horse. Perlino refers to double cream on a bay horse.
- 6. OPAL & SPECTRUM AWARDS FOR 10.2 HANDS & UNDER changes to the total points required. SECTION 1 total points required is 400 & SECTION 2 total points required is 300 making a total all up of 700 points.
